

SE District PAHA Judged Pleasure Ride

Sunday October 24, 2004

Southeast District will be having its 32nd annual Judged Pleasure Ride. It will be mainly over Cheshire Hunt Conservancy land and Brandywine Conservancy land. The ride will start from the Hannum field located on Newark Road just south of Rt. 82. It is about 3 miles west of Unionville. We start about 10:30 AM and should return around 3 PM with a one hour lunch break.

Participation is limited to PAHA members and their immediate families, Tri-County members, and/or horses owned by the above. A member may bring one or two guests provided he/she lets us know by October 17. Please bring your own lunch. We will take it to the lunch site and we will supply apples and cider.

Each horse will be assigned a number which must stay with it from the start to finish. Riders, however, may change horses as long as the number stays with the horse. Tack is optional. The fee is \$12 per horse if entered by October 17th.

Horses will be judged as pleasure trail ride mounts. If entries warrant, there will be six divisions as follows - Purebred Geldings, Purebred Mares, Purebred Stallions, Half/Anglo Geldings, Half/Anglo Mares, and other than Arabians. The "Others" are not eligible for Champion or Reserve. There will be several "Specialty Awards" and "Others" are eligible for those.

It is not mandatory that you be judged, but the fee and entry form must still be sent in so that we know how many to expect. All entries must be in by October 17th to receive the lower fee. Late and post entry fees are \$20 per horse.

NO SMOKING IS PERMITTED ON THE TRAIL.

Protective headgear is mandatory for juniors and strongly recommended for adults.
